**Aaron McNeil House** - Through the Crisis Relief Program, 268 individuals received critical assistance (Meds, Mortgage, Rent, Utilities, etc.). Through the Food Pantry and TEFAP, over \$480k in food was distributed to 9,207 households.

**American Red Cross** - 97 families received immediate relief (food, shelter, clothing, etc.) following home fire disasters.

**Armed Services YMCA** - Provided invaluable child care and educational and mentoring needs for 996 military children.

**Boys & Girls Club** - Over 400 youth participated in the Academic Success Program, which assists with homework help and tutoring, STEM activities, a Summer Learning Loss Program, a Workforce Development Program, and college & career readiness field trips & programs.

**CC Literacy Council** - Introduced the power of reading to 5,879 children through 4 programs (Community Reader Day, Real Men Read Program, Literacy Council Spelling Bee, Cookies With Santa Program). Additionally, over 400 educators and school staff were honored through the Teacher Appreciation Outreach Program.

**CC Rescue Team** - Responded to 352 Critical Emergencies with life-saving equipment and expertly trained volunteers. 47 volunteers devoted 1,412 hours to save lives and livelihoods.

**CC Youth Services Advisory Board** - Provided much needed incentives and social and recreational opportunities for 34 at-risk youth at the Christian County Day Treatment and Hopkinsville Group Home.

**Dyslexia Association** - Specialized tutoring & education were provided to 86 individuals with reading deficiencies.

**Hopkinsville Family YMCA** - Served 49,055 youth, young adults, and seniors through 3 programs (Healthy Living, Youth Development, Social Responsibility).

**Imagination Library** - Encouraging early Childhood Development, free monthly books were provided to 2,949 children ages 0-5.

**Kentucky Legal Aid** - Provided free legal services to 651 disadvantaged individuals and families, the elderly, and the disabled.

**Pennyroyal Children's Advocacy Center** - Provided confidential and compassionate medical testing and services to 150 children who have experienced sexual abuse and trauma.

**PACS Home Delivered Meals** - Delivered daily hot meals and a familiar face to 1,188 seniors.

**PACS RSVP** - Senior volunteers were able to stay active by providing over 45,463 volunteer hours to non-profits.

**Sanctuary, Inc.** - Provided safety and support to 246 victims of abuse and their families.

**St. Luke Free Clinic** - Free health care and life saving medications were provided to 169 uninsured or underinsured working adults.

**The Salvation Army** - Served 50,579 meals from the soup kitchen to individuals experiencing hunger and provided shelter to 267 unhoused individuals/families.

**Trace Industries** - Provided day training services and camp experience to 43 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
